

German – Danish Autumn Championship

Regularity with Orientation Stages

Three races are scored:

- 18.09.2021 Denmark MKC / SMKG (Funen)

Licenses are required for foreign participants in Denmark; the Danish clubs provide licenses for one day. Driver and co-driver are rated separately. The winner is the participant with the highest number of points resulting from the class results of the events. All classes advertised by the organizer count towards the overall result. In the event of a tie, the longer penalty point at the respective event counts.

Per race: 50 points are awarded for 1st place, 48 points for 2nd place, 47 points for 3rd place, and so on. There are no deletion results. A race must have ended in classification. At least one race must be contested in the respective country. A participant who is acting as a marshall receives a one-off credit for the average value of his race.

Prize money will be awarded to each team for the autumn championship. If only one driver or co-driver is placed, the prize money is reduced by half.

1st Place: 200 EUR | 2nd Place: 100 EUR | 3rd Place: 50 EUR

The prize giving takes place at the last run of the autumn championship. If someone to be honored is not present, the prize money will be forfeited and will be awarded again in the prize money pot for the following year. Subsequent teams do not move up. Any material prizes, instead of prize money, are forfeited.
